

We have completed the extension of our route and invite you to walk it.

You will be transported from Cape Town to the quaint little town of Aurora at the foot of the Piketberg mountains. This little town becomes bright orange during the flower season of July, August & September. You leave Aurora at first light and walk for 25kms to your first stop on the extension route which is Klein Tafelberg. The road is dusty and long, the terrain is harsh.



At the end of this first day of walking, you spend the night at a campsite called Klein Tafelberg. It is well marked and is an oasis in the hot, dry Sandveld. Klein Tafelberg looks vastly different from different angles but is an extraordinary feature that stands out on the landscape.

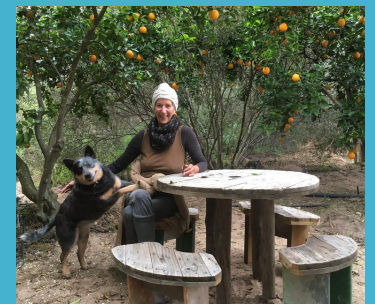

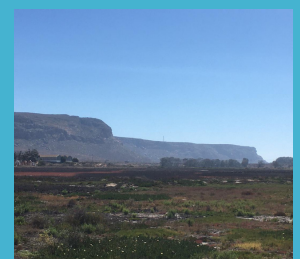
The next day you cross several farms over 14kms and make your way to Redelinghuys. A charming village built on a major aquifer, giving this little town access to abundant water. You will spend the night with the locals.



You leave Redelinghuys the next day and travel 16kms to a beautiful local farm Klarefontein, with typical rural hospitality, offered by Cape farming communities.



Now you turn towards the sea. Every day you set off nice and early at first light, today included. You cross Verlorenvlei and head towards Elands Bay. Along the route you'll stop and explore the famous Diepkloof caves where there are abundant bushmen paintings. You spend the night in the seaside village of Elands Bay, famous for its superb wave.





The next three days are spent on the Cape West Coast, between Elands Bay and Velddrif. You will pass a crayfish factory along the way, and the well known Elands Bay cave where there is an easily accessible bushman painting. You spend the first night in Fork West, 21km from Elands Bay, and sleep in glamping accommodation in the sand dunes. In the morning you head to Dwarskersbos and visit once again with locals living in this sea side village. Icy waters, Atlantic sunsets, whales in whale season and known for the white washed holiday homes.



You end our Country Route in Veldrif.
A town built on the Berg River mouth and well known for it's harbour and pink flamingos. You spend the night in the local hotel on the water.



In the morning after breakfast you get transported back to Cape Town.
